He's the best-selling author of the dramatic non-fiction title, *Alive: The Story of the Andes Survivors*, later made into an acclaimed film. As a biographer, he was chosen to write the official account of Sir Alec Guinness's life. His novels have won praise and awards. And now he's headed back to the bestseller lists with his new novel of suspense, *The Death of a Pope*.

In Piers Paul Read's *The Death of a Pope*, we meet Juan Uriarte, a handsome and outspoken Spanish ex-priest, seems to be the model of nonviolence and compassion for the poor and downtrodden. When the death of Pope John Paul II brings about the conclave that will elect Joseph Ratzinger as Pope Benedict XVI, a terrorist plot involving blackmail, subterfuge, and mass murder begins to fall into place . . . a plot that could spell disaster for the Catholic Church and the world.
