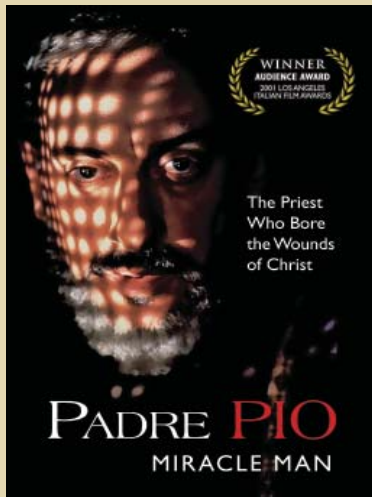

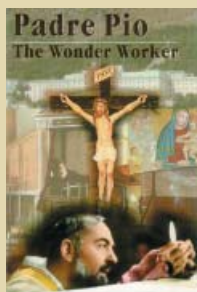


Padre Pio: Miracle Man

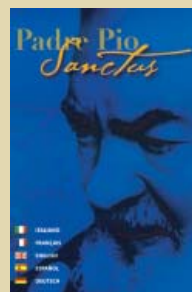


Padre Pio The Wonder Worker

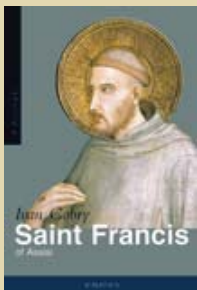


Padre Pio: Sanctus

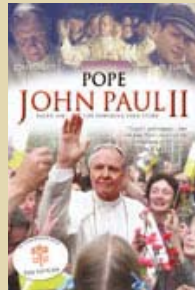


Saint Francis of Assisi A Biography
